PAULO SZOT - Baritone

Paulo Szot is one of the most acclaimed and versatile baritones in the world having garnered international acclaim as an opera singer, an award winning musical theatre star, a consummate concert performer and an actor.

Paulo Szot was born in São Paulo and raised in Ribeirão Pires, Brazil. He began his musical training at the age of five, first studying piano and later adding violin and dance. Szot studied at the Jagiellonian University in Poland, the country from which his parents had emigrated during World War II. He began singing professionally in 1989 with the Polish National Song and Dance Company Slask, and in 1997 he made his operatic debut as Figaro in II



Barbiere di Siviglia in a production of the **Theatro Municipal de São Paulo**, directed by Enzo Dara and conducted by Luiz Fernando Malheiro.

He has gone on to appear with most major opera companies throughout the world in Europe, the United States. Australia and Brazil.

In 2008, Szot was cast as <u>Emile De Becque</u> in the Broadway revival of *South Pacific* at **Lincoln Center Theatre**, directed by Bartlett Sher. He was awarded with the Tony Award, Drama Desk, Outer Critic's Circle and Theater World Awards for his portrayal, becoming one of a few actors to receive such honors on a Broadway debut.

Szot appeared in a solo concert in the Allen Room at Jazz at Lincoln Center as part of the American Songbook Series, and several times at New York City's prestigious Café Carlyle and 54 Below for a series of critically acclaimed solo performances.

In concert, he appeared with the New York Philharmonic alongside Liza Minnelli conducted by Marvin Hamlisch, and made his **Carnegie Hall** debut with the New York Pops Orchestra in a program of Lerner and Loewe with Kelli O'Hara. He performed in a solo recital at **Teatro Real de Madrid** as a salute to Frank Sinatra's & Antonio C. Jobim.

He returned in 2013 to the **New York Philharmonic** for a solo concert "An Evening with Paulo Szot" conducted by Ted Sperling and for the 2016/17 New Year's Eve Gala with Joyce DiDonato conducted by Alan Gilbert.

To his native Brazil, Szot has returned many times to perform with the major orchestras and opera companies including Osesp, TMSP, TMRJ, Teatro São Pedro, Teatro Amazonas, Filarmônica MG, OPES, OMB, OSB, Palácio das Artes, among others, both with symphonic and operatic repertoire. Also, in São Paulo he starred as Henry Higgins in the 2016 revival of My Fair Lady at the Teatro Santander, directed by Jorge Takla.

With more than 70 opera productions in his résumé since 1997, Szot had his **Metropolitan Opera** debut in 2010 as <u>Kovalyov</u> in *The Nose* by Dimitri Shostakovich, conducted by Valery Gergiev and directed by William Kentridge. He returned to the Met for the six following seasons as <u>Escamillo</u> in Carmen (2011), <u>Lescaut</u> in Manon (2012), <u>Kovalyov</u> in The Nose (2013), <u>Dr. Falke</u> in Die Fledermaus (2013/14), <u>The Captain</u> in John Adams' The Death of Klinghoffer (2014), Dr. Falke in Die Fledermaus (2015/16) and as <u>Sharpless</u> in Madama Butterfly (2019/20).

At the **Teatro Alla Scala**, made his debut in 2013 in the main role of <u>Prof. F. Filippovich</u> in the opera A Dog's Heart by Aleksander Raskatov, directed by Simon McBurney.

At the **Opera National de Paris**, Szot had his debut in 2012 as <u>Guglielmo</u> in Cosi fan Tutte.

Other favorite performances have included the title role in **Don Giovanni** at the **Dallas Opera**, Washington National Opera, Bordeaux, Toulon, Sao Paulo, Manaus, Bogotá; Count Almaviva in Le Nozze di Figaro at the New York City Opera, Antwerpen Opera, Aix-en-Provence Festival, Boston, Sao Paulo and Bahrain; the title role in Eugene Onegin at the Opera de Marseille and Opera Australia; Escamillo in Carmen at the Bayerische Staatsoper, San Francisco Opera, NYCO, Palm Beach Opera, TMSP, TMRJ: Dr. Falke in Die Fledermaus at the Metropolitan Opera, Sharpless in Madama Butterfly at Opera Municipal de Marseille; Lescaut in Manon at the Festival Amazonas, Teatro Alfa with Rosana Lamosa and at Metropolitan Opera with Anna Netrebko; <u>Don Alfonso</u> in the newest production of Cosi fan Tutte at the **Opera National de Paris**, conducted by Philippe Jordan and directed by Anne Teresa De Keersmaeker, Frank Mourrant in Kurt Weill's Street Scene at the **Teatro Real** and **Opera Monte Carlo**. With <u>Osesp</u> in Brazil, to perform Mahler's Rückert Lieder; in San Francisco/Palm Springs/54 Below presented with his new solo show "An Evening with Paulo Szot"; Muscat Opera in Oman for a solo Concert with Mozart's baritones Arias; as Giorgio Germont in La Traviata at Palácio das Artes/MG and Theatro Municipal de São Paulo; The Celebrant in Bernstein's Mass both in London's SouthBank Centre and at The Ravinia Festival conducted by Marin Alsop; in Sydney and Melbourne with the Opera Australia in a production of Evita, as <u>Juan Peron</u> opposite with Tina Arena; **Opera di Roma** as Count Danilo in Lehar's Merry Widow; OSESP, in Brazil as their's Artist in Residence (2019), Chicago The Musical on Broadway in 2019/21 and in 2022, Sao Paulo. in & Juliet on Broadway in the role of Lance DuBois.
